

What is the Burlington County Bird Quest?

- A way to discover Burlington County's parks and natural areas
- A way to discover the unique birds that live in and migrate through our county
- A chance to learn how to identify birds by sight, sound, behavior, and habitat
- A chance to have fun with friends and colleagues
 - A light-hearted competition

Who can participate?

- People of all ages may form teams:
 - Families
 - Friends
 - Scout groups
 - School groups
 - Clubs



How does it work?

- Team size varies. One or more persons should be able to identify some birds by sight and/or sound. At least half should be novices: people interested in learning.
- A packet of information is mailed to every registered team before Bird Quest.
- On Saturday, May 4, 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, teams can visit sites of their choice in Burlington County. Birds are identified by sight and/or sound. The goal is to find as many different species as possible.
- At 12:15 p.m., all teams gather at Palmyra Cove Nature Park to report results, determine a winning team, have lunch, and receive prizes.

Is there a cost?

There is a **\$10.00 per person cost** to participate in Burlington County Bird Quest.

If your team includes persons under the age of 18, you should obtain parental permission and include two adults as part of your team.

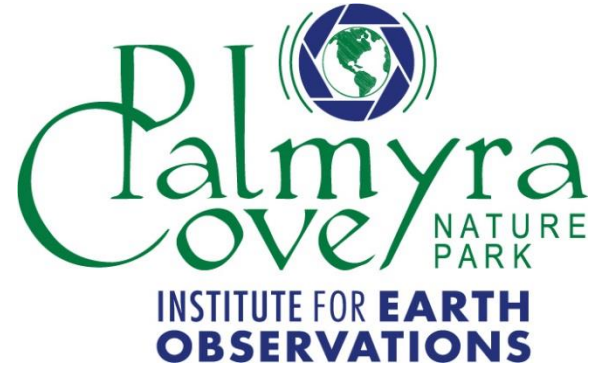
