**DIRECTIONS TO THE PALMYRA COVE
NATURE PARK AND ENVIRONMENTAL
DISCOVERY CENTER**

From New Jersey via Route 73

Option 1: Travel on Route 73 north towards the Tacony-Palmyra Bridge. Take the jug handle at FC Kerbeck; cross over Route 73; on the right (wooden gates) enter Park Drive to the Palmyra Cove Nature Park Environmental Discovery Center parking lot.

Option 2: Travel on Route 73 north towards the Tacony-Palmyra Bridge. Make a right at the last light before the bridge at Souder Street (Dunkin Donuts); follow to the stop sign (Temple Boulevard), make a left; just before the Toll Plaza, make a right into the driveway, follow the roadway behind the Toll Building and under the bridge, the Palmyra Cove Nature Park (Environmental Discovery Center) is just thru the wooden gates under the bridge.

From River Road (Broad Street)

Travel West towards Route 73; at Cinnaminson Avenue, make a right; at Temple Boulevard (blinking light), make a left; just before the Toll Plaza, make a right into the driveway, follow the roadway behind the Toll Building and under the bridge, the Palmyra Cove Nature Park (Environmental Discovery Center) is just thru the wooden gates under the bridge.

From Philadelphia via Tacony Palmyra Bridge

Option 1: Keep left as you pass the Bridge Toll Plaza and take the left hand turn lane. Make the left on to Souder Street; follow to the stop sign (Temple Boulevard), make a left; just before the Toll Plaza, make a right into the driveway, follow the roadway behind the Toll Building and under the bridge, the Palmyra Cove Nature Park (Environmental Discovery Center) is just thru the wooden gates under the bridge.

Option 2: Continue on 73 South after crossing the bridge. Make a right turn about ¼ mile after the bridge (entrance to the flea market and park). Enter wooden gates on your right onto Park Drive; follow Park Drive to the parking area

Palmyra Cove Nature Park's summer camp is for children who enjoy being outdoors and making new discoveries. Our mission is to have students feel a sense of responsibility and ownership of our wild spaces and to learn about their environment in a fun and educational way.

Environmental education at Palmyra Cove is hands-on, interdisciplinary, and personalized. Each week of camp will cover different topics, so Campers may participate in one or both weeks.

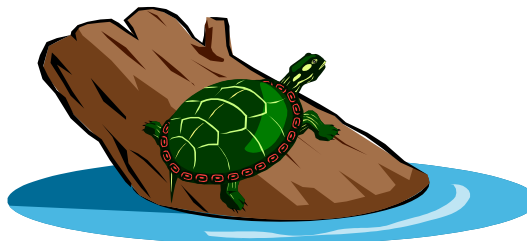
Our Cove Campers will be split into teams according to the grade they will be entering in the fall. Cove Campers summer camp is for students entering grades 1 through 8. We have extended camp by an hour, so the campers will need to bring a healthy lunch with them.

A Family Walk will be held on the Friday following each week of camp, from 6:30pm to 8:30pm, for all participating campers and their families.

Our Cove Campers will learn to conduct scientific experiments, including the use of technology and math skills, to learn about the natural world. Some of the activities will include:

- **Seining and beach pollution surveys**
- **Wetland flora and fauna discoveries**
- **Amphibian and reptile studies**
- **Delaware River watershed investigations**
- **Habitat creation**
- **Natural and recycled arts and crafts projects.**
