

Ongoing Activities at Palmyra Cove Nature Park

All activities can be scheduled by calling (856-829-1900 x 263) or emailing (esanderson@bcbridges.org) to reserve a date and time. Each group activity requires a minimum of 4 people, with the exception of the Park Safari Ride.

- **Orienteering** – Families and small groups can explore Palmyra Cove Nature Park by using a map and compass. In this 3-hour activity, participants learn to use a compass and map in brief hands-on activities. They then use their skills to complete the park course.
Fee: \$10 per person; members FREE
- **Park Safari Ride** – See the various ecosystems of the park by riding in our utility vehicle. Your ride includes an interpretive tour led by park personnel. Rides must be scheduled 2 weeks in advance and will be canceled during inclement weather. Dates and times are flexible (no Sundays).
Fee: \$5 per person (minimum 2 people, maximum 4 adults); members FREE
- **Night Hike** – Explore life after dark at Palmyra Cove Nature Park. Many of the park animals have adapted to darkness and are most active between dusk and dawn. Participate in some sensory activities and learn about the wonders of the night. Allow 1.5 hours for this activity.
Fee: \$8 per person; members FREE
- **Wildlife Observation Hike** - This activity is great for young learners. Participants classify and categorize living things by observing signs and actual sightings of wildlife. Allow 1.5 hours for this activity.
Fee: \$8 per person; members FREE
- **Wetlands Ecology Study** – Learn about the animals, plants, soils, and hydrology of our vernal pool and pond. Hands-on activities that involve observing and identifying aquatic organisms. Allow 2 hours for this activity. Participants must wear clothes that can get wet and dirty.
Fee: \$8 per person; members FREE
- **Forest Ecology Study** – Decomposers are a vital part of a forest ecosystem. Learn how a fallen log contributes to the health and vitality of a forest by observing and identifying decomposers and other organisms. Allow 2 hours for this activity.
Fee: \$8 per person; members FREE
