

Winter Rent A Hike at Palmyra Cove

In order to accommodate busy schedules, Palmyra Cove will offer winter hikes from 8 AM to 3 PM any weekday, December through March. All hiking activities are approximately 2 hours (advanced orienteering – 3 hours) and free to members (\$8 per person for non-members).

Choose from the list of hikes below and please permit 1 week's notice.

Advanced Orienteering – use a compass and map to locate markers dispersed throughout the park (allow 3 hours; Orienteering a prerequisite).

Animals in Winter – Observe evidence of how animals adapt to winter conditions.

Beaver Pond Hike – Enjoy the park as we hike to Beaver Pond to observe the latest beaver activity.

Daytime Owl Prowl – look for clues and possible sightings of owls that frequently inhabit the Cove.

Orienteering – learn to interpret and use a map as you navigate throughout our park (prerequisite for advanced orienteering).

Red Fox Hike – Search for the elusive Red Fox by locating dens, tracks, scat and prey.

Wildlife Observation Hike - Explore the forest, field and wetland habitats of Palmyra Cove and observe a variety of plants and animals along the way.
